P&C MEETING

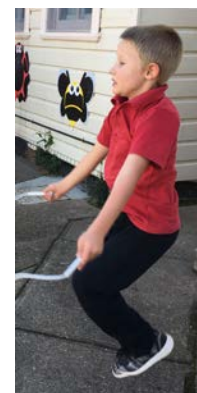
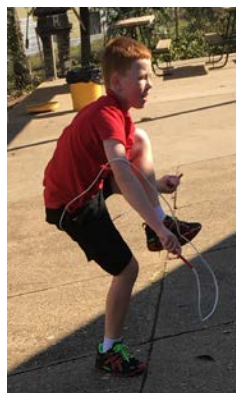
Our P&C meeting will be held today at 5pm. All members and those thinking about joining are invited to attend.
