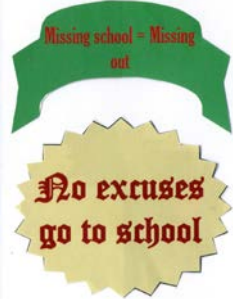

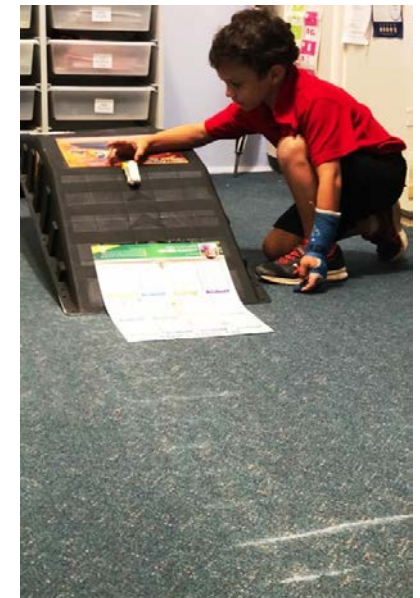

Waste to Art Competition

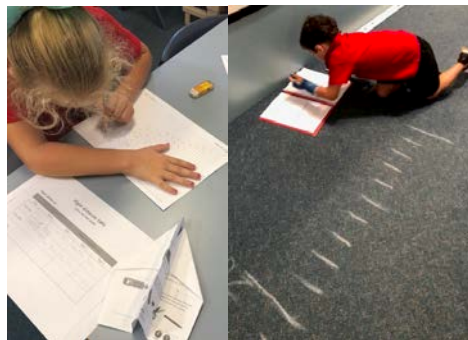
Infant students received a Highly Commended award & \$50 prize money with their artwork – hands on culture.
