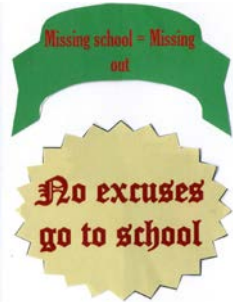

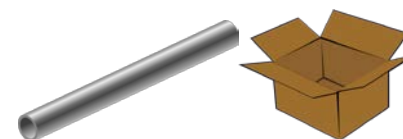
SCHOOL PHOTOS
