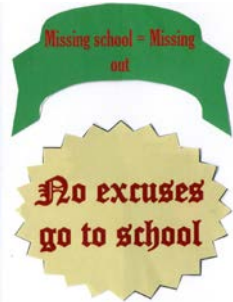

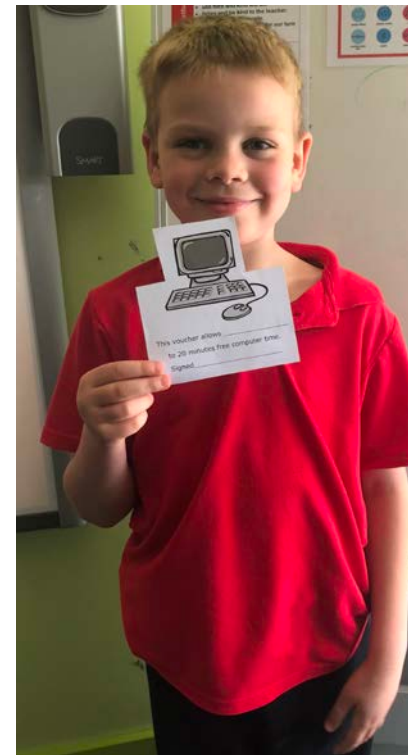

Our next P&C meeting will be held on the 23rd August. It would be wonderful to see as many members there as

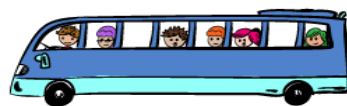
possible to help us continue to build our school community together.
